Christ Alive Care Ministries, India (Building Project Started)

TTWM has had the privilege to be a part of several ministry opportunities since the return of the mission team to India in July. As I write this newsletter there is a Children’s Home being built in Kerala for the precious orphans at Christ Alive Care Ministries (CACM), a partner of TTWM. TTWM was able to send over funds to help with the first phase of this building project. Agape Christian Mission, India Land Purchased...

Agape Christian Mission in Salem, India, a partner of TTWM, has purchased land outside the city of Salem. Pastor Nehemiah Rajan, and his wife Helen have a heart to build a Champions Home on this property. They are now taking care of fifty two children, but when the Home is complete they will have one hundred children. TTWM has been matching funds with other partners of ACM to help in the purchase of this land.

River Jordan Champions Home, Kenya (Milk Cow Project)

TTWM has started a Milk Cow Project at River Jordan Champions Home in Kenya. TTWM contributors have purchased land for growing grass needed for feed and a third and fourth grade Sunday School Class raised the funds to purchase the cows. The grass is now growing on the land, the first cow has been purchased, and a shelter has been built for the cow. The children at RJ are happy and praising God because they are now drinking milk from their own cow. We praise the Lord for River Jordan Champions Home. The construction of River Jordan began in 2006. We now have on this site a dormitory that houses one hundred precious, joyful children; a school; a medical clinic; dairy, poultry, and tailoring projects.
