Fall has returned to the mountains of Western North Carolina. With it comes the assurance that God is still on His throne. Also, it brings God's beautiful tapestry of fall colors. Only He can create something so magnificently beautiful and vast in its proportions. Fall has also come to the gorgeous Carpathian Mountains of Southern Romania, from which I have recently returned. Last month Raymond Banner and I traveled to Turni Severin, Romania to participate in the graduation exercises of the first class of graduates from the Vasile Gherman Bible School. There we joined Dr. Randy Mann, associate pastor of Wake Crossroads Baptist Church in Raleigh and Brett Ciancanelli,



founder and president of The Second Wind Ministries. They had been in Romania for the week teaching the last quarter's material for the students. The graduation of these 17 students was the realization of a five year dream of mine and the result of three years of sacrifice on the part of many people. Without the support of Dr. Danny Akin and the professors at S.E.B.T.S. this dream could not have happened. In a short article it is impossible to mention all who had part in making this happen. However, there are three that God used to work out all the details



and take care of all the logistics as the three years progressed. On the American side David Cooper, Director of Projects for TTW, literally did all the work. On the Romanian side Pavel Ureche,

pastor of The First Baptist Church in Turni Severin, and Alin Costache, secretary of the school, did the work there. However, we know all the glory goes to our Heavenly Father who gave all for us. There are now seventeen men trained and qualified to minister in the churches in the small villages in Southern Romania that cannot afford a full time pastor.
